The International Fascial Manipulation Course for Physicians with Prof. Carla Stecco in Münster in June 2019 was a great success. The 4-day course has shown that fascial manipulation and shockwave therapy complement each other perfectly, and that they can be taught together both theoretically and practically in a medical course. Unfortunately, the pandemic blocked us for almost two years. But it has also brought us new and more flexible forms of teaching.
